Eton Residents Ordering from Budgens

For those who are unable to collect their own groceries, Budgens are now able to take email orders for essential items which will be delivered by volunteers. [We anticipate that ordering by phone will be available in the future.]

The email system is as follows:

Budgens have a list of essential items that can be ordered by email and delivered by volunteers

Orders are placed by emailing eton@kavanaghgroup.ie

This is best done by using the list overleaf.

Alternatively, the items can be emailed as a list.

You must include in your order the following information:

Name

Phone number

Street name, Post code and house/flat number

Area number e.g. Area 5, or Area 10 etc (so that Budgens can email the correct area delivery team when your order is ready for collection).

Orders that arrive before 10.45am will be bagged up by lunchtime.

Budgens will then call you to confirm the contents of your order and to ask for your payment card details.

Once the groceries are paid for, Budgens will contact the volunteer deliverers in your Area to tell them that your order is ready to be delivered.

Please note that the system is strictly for those who are unable to collect their own groceries.
