### 3. Matters Arising from Minutes

- i. **Keates Lane roadworks and traffic lights:** lots of communications between RBWM, and Eton Town Council; the new traffic lights will be very configurable so can be altered if necessary  
Action: feedback concerns about lights changing to red too quickly      **RR/MA**
- ii. **JH to give copy of minutes to Sally Adams:** done
- iii. **White painted cycle turn left on cobbles by Windsor bridge hadn't been repainted:** has now been repainted

### 4. RBWM Councillor Matters incl. current traffic works

- i. **Elections on 2<sup>nd</sup> May:** Windsor has low council tax compared to other parts of the UK outside of London; there has been criticism of the new banners
- ii. **Keates Lane traffic lights:** work should finish by end February, comms with Chris Wheeler included bus provision.

- iii. **Eton College Sports facilities planning application:** RBWM planning have approved this and the college are currently working on a legal agreement with RBWM
- iv. **Eton Information Centre:** Written confirmation from RBWM to access £50,000 through a Community Interest Company
- v. **Residents car parking spaces:** have been painted blue to easily differentiate from the others
- vi. **Car parking machines:** trial of new machines has started in River Street car park; two problems being worked on
  - 1. Doesn't work with Advantage cards which are older than 2 years
  - 2. Doesn't work with Advantage cards that haven't been used within the last few months
 Action: apply for new Advantage card if you want to use the new machines and your card is more than two years old **All**
- vii. **RR is in dialogue with Chris Wheeler RBWM re Eton Action List:**
- viii. **Thames Water pavement repair after work outside Porny School:** paving has been replaced by gradually sinking tarmac, the road crossing lady has reported this
- ix. **Anthony spontaneously thanked Councillor MA on behalf of ECA for all that he has achieved for this ward:** he will be standing next for the ward in which he lives

## 5. Alexander Devine

- i. KW introduced George Torpey from the Alexander Devine charity.
- ii. GT shared pictures showing how funds are spent, and summarised ECA contributions from Christmas lights switch ons. He thanked us for these contributions. ECA has also fed in contributions from other events such as the Magna Carta fête.
- iii. The hospice currently supports 116 children from Berkshire and surrounding areas, 182 since the hospice opened. There are 630 children in Berkshire who could benefit. 84% of donations are spent on care.
- iv. More funds are needed. The hospice has 6 bedrooms but each needs 6 nurses to be used 24x7. The hospice is expanding and advertising for staff but needs to raise much more money to run the bedrooms.
- v. Need to spread the word that the hospice still needs funds. GT happy to speak to appropriate organisations. MA will tell the Inner Wheel. GT will contact our local MP.

## 6. Chairman's Report

- i. **Shoutout and the Eton Community Website will be more clear about dates and will include Eton Wick events:** Russell Lloyd does this very well.
- ii. **Eton Action List:** thanks to Cllr Malcolm A for getting the residents parking spaces clearly marked; there are more bicycle hoops just over the bridge which can be used in addition to those in Eton
- iii. **Information centre:** RR explained where we are with funding for this; the Christopher Wren have offered 100 dining places for dinner (excluding wine) on 3<sup>rd</sup> May – ECA will sell tickets and run an auction – proceeds to go towards funding the information centre; the Information Centre will soon appear as a Green Redeem option <https://www.greenredeem.co.uk/rbwm>; investigating Community Interest Company – maybe using the Windsor & District CIC; CIC is route to the £50k funding which Cllrs have helped to secure, including Cllr Samantha Rayner. Cllr MA wants done by 5<sup>th</sup> April; we are working with Julia White to coordinate with tourist activities and similar organisations
- iv. **May elections:** AC asked for more information; MA will be standing for Clewer & Dedworth West; there will be 3 councillors for Eton & Castle including Eton Wick; RR thanked MA for all that he has achieved for Eton
- v. **Volunteers wanted:** for schools for example to replace sheds
- vi. **Street Clean 24<sup>th</sup> March:** starts 11:00 with 12:30 bacon butties and pastries
- vii. **Wifi:** plan is to attach bounce points to bulkhead lights, council will fund a pull test to check that these are sufficiently strong
- viii. **Flagpole review and slipway:** nothing discussed
- ix. **High Street retailers:**

Cosmetic shop still planned for ex-Turner & Tom site  
Makena has closed – might become an artisan bread shop

- x. **Cockpitt:** delayed by change of tenant next door who needed to agree access, this has now been sorted
